All entrant vehicles must be scrutineered.

MAPPENS :

Scrutineering is where you'll get your passes, stickers, and entrant pack.

HEAD TO COMPETITOR GATE AND FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS OF OUR FRIENDLY OFFICIALS.

ISYOUR CAR REGISTERED?

If you can drive it on the road, drive it to scrutineering — don't trailer it! It will be much quicker for you.

We are an IHRA sanctioned event. This means we operate under their safety and competition regulations. Any vehicle participating in driving events will be scrutineered according to the IHRA Standards.

WHERE & WHEN

Check your ticket for your scrutineering time slot. Please don't come any earlier — you will be asked to wait until your allocated time.

Scrutineering is located in the Cream Scrutineering Shed.

- Once you have received your entrant wrist band at Competitor Gate, proceed through to scrutineering.
- If you have a trailer, please unload before heading into scrutineering.
- Drive to scrutineering.
- Entrant stickers are provided after you pass scrutineering.

SAFETYNOTICE

Please make sure you stay in your car at all times for everyone's safety.

TRAILER PARKING

Trailers must be unloaded and parked in the designated trailer parking area.

PASSENGERS

Passengers are to sign on to the indemnity waiver at scrutineering. If scrutineering is closed, passengers can sign on at the merchandise box.

- Make sure your car meets the requirements
- This is where you collect your entrant stickers and passenger arm bands if required
- Driving event requirements must be met
- Unregistered ATVS, Quad Bikes, Motorbikes, Golf Buggies or Electric/Motorised Devices including Bikes, Scooters, Skateboards or similar, are prohibited at this venue, exceptions being authorised tow vehicles during drag racing
- The entered driver must be with the vehicle during scrutineering no driver swaps!

 Pre-judging is done through scrutineering but final judging happens over Saturday in the pits


GRIFE SUPERCRUISE

INFO

Cruising at Northern Nats is a highlight. One of the only events in the country you can take your mates for a lap down a fully-fledged drag strip.

SUPERCRUISE

Make some noise during the Supercruise, showing off your pride and joy's performance — sending it along the drag strip and making some smoke up the burnout pad of Springmount Raceway. How awesome!



PASSENGERS

- Maximum four (4) people per vehicle
- All passengers and drivers must be seated and wear a seatbelt at all times
- All passengers must sign the indemnity waiver prior to going in the Supercruise
- Minimum age of passengers is 16 years old
- Passengers must wear a minimum of shorts, shirt and closed toe shoes

TRACK

- Maximum speed on the drag strip is 80km/hr
- Maximum speed on the return road is 40km/hr
- Other than leaving the start line area, no stopping or burnouts permitted on the drag strip
- Slow points must be driven in a managed and responsible manner
- Vehicles must stay in allocated lanes at all times
- Officials are there to keep you safe, follow their directions
- Slow points on track must be driven in a managed and responsible manner
- No static burnouts or popped tyres

VEHCLE / ENTRANT

- Entrants are the only people permitted to drive at Northern Nats
- All vehicles must have operative four-wheel brakes
- Bonnets on for Supercruise
- Driver and passengers must wear a minimum of shorts, shirt and closed toe shoes
- Random breath testing will occur during all activities

EORM UP


Head to the staging lanes to hit the tarmac.

DRIVERS BRIEFING

 Kids are allowed for cruising sessions. Please ensure they are in a road approved restraint for their age group.

SAFEMENUPMENT

- No burnouts during this time
- All passengers must have seatbelts
- No riding in back of utes or wagons
- Vehicles must have a bonnet







- Follow direction of officials
- Kids under 16 can't go in the Supercruise



INFO

Skid Row is located in the staging lanes where entrants can turn tyres in a safe environment with a packed crowd watching on. You do not have to be scrutineered for burnouts to use Skid Row.

WHO CAN DO IT

All entrants who are allowed to cruise.

SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- No popped tyres
- No static burnouts
- Bonnets on
- All passengers must be minimum 16 years old,
 with seatbelts on
- Entrants and passengers must have shirts and



- Bring your bonnet
- Kids under 16 aren't allowed in the car
- Follow direction from the officials
- Skid Row is for Skids
